



Spectator Information

The 2011 Rainworth Skoda Dukeries Rally welcomes spectators at the Start and Finish at Southwell Racecourse, the main Service Area at Thoresby Park and to several forest stage venues. Please only visit these venues and park in the car parks detailed. There is no public access to the other stage venues at the insistence of the landowners and police and to minimise PR issues which affect rallying in this area.

High Fire Risk - The forest vegetation is very dry and any ignition will spread rapidly.

The times shown are for the first rally car (Car 201). The rally cars are grouped into 3 sections. The first group numbered 201+ are cars up to 1400cc including BTRDA Rally First cars. The second group numbered 101+ are the 2 wheel drive cars including the pre 1981 Historic Rally cars of the type used on earlier Dukeries Rallies. Finally there will be the 4 wheel drive cars including the World Rally Cars (numbered 1+).

Cars start at 1 minute intervals so the whole field could take 2½ hours to pass through a stage.

Scrutineering / Documentation – Southwell Racecourse

Friday 10th June

The rally cars will undergo safety and technical checks and competitors will complete the documentation procedures between 4.00pm and 8.15pm.

Bar, fast food, toilets, programmes etc

From Southwell follow the large brown signs > Racecourse Main Entrance < Map Ref: 120/733.526

Please take care using the long straight approach road to the Racecourse. It is a quiet private road frequently used by children and dog walkers. Max Speed 30 mph

Start – Southwell Racecourse

Saturday 11th June

The first car (Car 201) will leave the start at **8.30am** with the others following at one minute intervals.

Stage 1 - Blidworth

First car due at 9.00am

Spectator parking and access to the stage is available at the Forestry Commission car park off Longdale Lane. Map Ref: 120/ 591 524.

Please do not use Blidworth Bottoms car park

Stage 3 - Rainworth Skoda Sherwood Pines

Map Ref: 120/ 611.638 **First car due at 10.00am**

Follow signs to the Sherwood Pines Visitor Centre off the B6030 into the forest. The visitor car park at Sherwood Pines has been enlarged and there are huge additional parking areas on the right hand side of the car park. £3 per day Pay & Display. To avoid queues please park up and then get a ticket from the machines.

Toilets / Programmes / Refreshments

From the car park it is a 300m walk west and south to the viewing areas.

Main Service Area – Thoresby Market Site

Map Ref: 120/628.709

From 11.00am to 2.30pm

Free spectator parking is adjacent to the Service Area. Do not use the Competitor entrance - follow the green spectator arrows. Please be aware of vehicles moving around the Service Area.

Each rally car will be in the Service Area for approx. 60 minutes.

Rally Results / Toilets / Food

Stage 5 - Watchwood

Map Ref: 120/585.505

First car due at 12.45pm

Approach from the B6386 (Calverton) down the 'no through road' which is blocked off from the A614. Pass the stage entrance and park at the end of road. Use the footpaths on the north side through Foxcovert Plantation which give direct access to fast S bends about 0.3 miles into the stage.

Please do NOT enter or exit the stage through the stage entrance. No parking on the A614 which is a Clearway!

Stage 8 - Rainworth Skoda Sherwood Pines 2

First car due at 1.55pm

Same parking location as the morning stage but with some changes to the stage route. The Pay & Display ticket is valid all day.

Finish and Awards Presentation – Southwell Racecourse

The cars will start to return to the Racecourse from **4.00pm** where the results will be displayed. The prize presentation will take place around **7.30pm**. Full bar, fast food, fish & chip shop, toilets

ATTENTION!



Rally cars move quickly and may:

- Run wide on corners
- Cut across corners
- Leave the road
- Throw up stones
- Do what you least expect



Enjoy rallying... but TAKE CARE!

DON'T.....

- Stand on the track
- Stand below the level of the track
- Stand in front of arrows or signs
- Stand in Prohibited Areas
- Stand or sit on or near log piles
- Sit close to the track
- Block escape routes
- Be distracted
- Play games with your safety

ALWAYS.....

- Expect the unexpected
- Listen for approaching cars
- Remain alert
- Leave yourself room to move quickly
- Try to keep behind something solid
- Keep children under close supervision
- Keep dogs on a lead
- Do as the Marshals ask
- Help the organisers to run a safe stage
